Purpose						
Rational						
Policy:						
Our Lady of the Lake University is committed to providing a healthy learning and working						
environment for all University community members and campus guests. While the University						
acknowledges that individuals may freely choose to smoke, such action will not be permitted to						
endanger the health of non-smokers or cause unreasonable discomfort or annoyance. The						
preponderance of medical research findings indicate that the health of non-smokers is						
endangered by exposure to secondary smoke.						
<ul> <li>The following guidelines regulate smoking, including cigarettes, cigars, pipes, e-cigarettes and vaping and chewing tobacco: <ul> <li>a. Smoking and tobacco products, including chewing tobacco are prohibited inside all University buildings. This includes common work areas, classrooms, conference and meeting rooms, private offices, residence halls, hallways, elevators, lounges, stairs, restrooms, the cafeteria and all other enclosed facilities.</li> <li>b. Smoking in the court yard or parking lots is also prohibited.</li> <li>c. Smoking is prohibited inside all University owned or leased vehicles.</li> <li>d. Students, faculty and staff may smoke in their personal vehicles, but must be completely contained within the vehicle.</li> </ul> </li> <li>This policy applies to all employees, students, consultants, contractors and customers. Failure to comply with all of the components of this policy may result in disciplinary action</li> </ul>						
Designated Areas						
The University allows smoking and tobacco products in the following outdoor areas:						
<ol> <li>Patio area behind the UWAC</li> <li>Picnic table area between the IFCC and Metz Hall</li> </ol>						
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3. Picnic table area by the lake on the far north end of Providence Hall						

- 4. Picnic table area between the Cyber Café and Ayers Hall's back entrance
- 5. Picnic table area on east side of Centennial Hall by grill
- 6. Picnic table area in front of the Worden Center
- 7. Picnic table area between Jersig and Library
- Picnic table area by the St. Martin Hall Annex, close to 24<sup>th</sup> street
   Shaded bench area outside Main closer to 24<sup>th</sup> street and Armadillo crossing sidewalk
- 10. Picnic table area by Maintenance Shop
- 11. Area between Walter Center and Thiry away from patio area
- 12. Bench area in in front of Moye

Employees who choose to use these designated areas do so at their own risk. No individual may smoke along pathways or walkways leading to or from the designated smoking areas.

Individuals must dispose of tobacco remains in the proper containers. This helps to keep a neat and clean environment for all including our visitors, partners and customers.

No additional breaks are allowed to any employee who smokes.
