Regent Policy Name: Tobacco-Free and Smoke-Free University Policy

Regent Policy Number: Regent Policy: B.20070

POLICY STATEMENT

Texas Woman's University (TWU) shall be designated a Tobacco-Free and Smoke-Free University. In its efforts to aid in the safety and welfare of its faculty, staff, students, and the TWU community, TWU discourages the use of all tobacco products and prohibits the use of all tobacco products on property owned or operated by TWU.

APPLICABILITY

This policy is applicable to TWU Students, Faculty, Staff, and Guests.

POLICY

I. Prohibition on Tobacco and Smoking Products

Section 1 Prohibition on Use. TWU prohibits the use of tobacco and smoking products indoors and outdoors at the TWU Denton, TWU Dallas, and TWU Houston campuses and facilities, including all student housing units. In addition, tobacco and the use of smoking products is prohibited in all TWU owned or leased vehicles.

Section 2 Prohibition on Other Activities. TWU prohibits the sale of tobacco products on all campuses. TWU also prohibits advertisements for tobacco in all official campus publications. The distribution of tobacco samples on all campuses is prohibited. TWU student organizations are prohibited from accepting money or gifts from tobacco companies.

II. University Regulations and Procedures – Tobacco and Smoking Free University

Adoption of Regulations and Procedures. TWU is committed to having campuses that are tobacco and smoking free environments. TWU shall adopt University

Regulations and Procedures concerning a Tobacco-Free and Smoke-Free University consistent with state and federal law.

REVIEW

This policy will remain in effect and published until it is reviewed, updated, or archived. This policy is to be reviewed once every six years. Interim review may be required as a result of updates to federal and state law or regulations, or internal processes or procedures.
