

Tobacco, Vapes and Related Products

Students should be aware of the many physical dangers associated with the use of smoking and tobacco products. To maintain a healthy environment and to encourage healthy lifestyles for all students, staff and faculty, use of all tobacco products (including smokeless tobacco) and vapes (vaporizers, e-cigarettes, etc.) is strictly prohibited on the ACU campus and other university property and at all university-sponsored activities, including sporting events. Use of any of these products in the residence halls and in University Park is a serious violation of this Handbook. The safety of all residents requires that students and their guests respect this policy. Students should be aware they may be held responsible for the actions of any of their visitors or guests.

Students who are found responsible for violating the University policy concerning the possession and/or use of tobacco products and vapes will be subject to a range and/or combination of sanctions that may include: (1) fines ranging from \$200 to \$300 for first time violations, increasing to a minimum of \$500 for repeat violations; (2) disciplinary probation; and (3) counseling; (4). Repeated violations can result in suspension from the university.
