

Tobacco

The College shall be a tobacco-free institution committed to providing its students and employees with a safe and healthy environment. The use of tobacco products of any kind, including e-cigarettes shall be prohibited on all College property, in all College facilities, and at all College related activities and events. This shall include all buildings, grounds, sidewalks and streets within the campus property. This policy applies to all students, staff, faculty, and visitors--and also applies to all College vehicles.

Life Threatening Behavior

When it is determined by Campus Police and/or the Behavioral Intervention Team that a student may pose a danger to themselves or others, the student will be referred to the college mental health counselor and the chair of the Behavioral Intervention Team to conduct a non-clinical suicidal assessment. If the student is determined to be a threat to themselves, they will be referred to the hospital emergency room for a further clinical assessment by the mobile crisis unit. Once the student has returned to campus a referral to the campus counselor will be given.
